Public Health State of Emergency

The Public Health State of Emergency has been extended through June 12, 2020. The original Public Health State of Emergency order will stay in force through the new date just announced. This order states that the medically fragile and elderly Georgians need to continue to shelter in place through June 12, 2020. This order also will require long-term care facilities – including nursing homes, personal care homes, assisted living facilities, and similar community living homes – to utilize enhanced infection control protocols, ensure safer living conditions, and protect residents and staff from coronavirus exposure.
