

COURTHOUSE COVID-19 SCREENING PROTOCOL

Instructions for courthouse security or designated employees:

Upon entering the courthouse, all visitors must attest to or acknowledge to no known illness by responding to the following statements. It is also recommended that persons conducting the screenings should wear a mask and sterile gloves while practicing social distancing with no less than a three (3) foot barrier.

COVID-19 SAMPLE SCREENING STATEMENTS

- I attest that I have not traveled to a high-risk area or location identified as a “hot spot” of confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) cases within the last 14 days.
- I attest that I have not tested positive for COVID-19 or been instructed to isolate or quarantine by a healthcare provider within the past 14 days.
- To the best of my knowledge, I have not had contact with a person confirmed or presumed to have coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last 14 days.
- I attest that I have not, within the past ten days, experienced symptoms of COVID-19, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever above 100 degrees, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, headache, or new loss of taste or smell.
- I attest that I have not exhibited a fever of 100° F or higher within the last 72 hours.
